DAY 2 - ZURICH

RHINE FALLS



To stand high above Europe's largest waterfall, feeling the roar and vibration of the water over one's entire body - this can be experienced at the Rhine Falls near Schaffhausen. By ship one can reach castles, the Rhine Falls Basin and even the mighty rock in the midst of the waterfall. Experience the Rhine Falls with (almost) all your senses by taking a boat trip downstream along one of the Rhine's most beautiful river landscapes.

LINDT HOME OF CHOCOLATE

In an impressive new building designed by star architects Christ & Gantenbein, the Lindt Home of Chocolate welcomes chocolate lovers from all over the world to Kilchberg on Lake Zurich.

An interactive multimedia exhibition guides visitors through seven different chocolate worlds, which appeal to all the senses. From the cultivation of cocoa to the history of chocolate through to tasting the top-quality Swiss chocolate – here you can find out everything you need to know on the subject. In addition, interested visitors can view the latest production and automation technologies at a show production facility.

DAY 3 – ZURICH/LUCERNE

LUCERNE PRESENTATION

Historic houses decorated with frescoes line the picturesque town squares as they do the 'Weinmarkt' square in the car-free old town. Lucerne is a city of town squares and churches. The Jesuit church dating from the 17th century is regarded as Switzerland's first sacral Baroque building and the twin towers of the Hofkirche form an integral part of the townscape. The figure of a dying lion which was hewn from the face of rock in remembrance of the heroic death of Swiss guards killed during an attack on the Tuileries in 1792 is one of the best-known monuments in Switzerland.

DAY 4 – LUCERNE

Full day excursion to Mount Pilatus



MOUNT PILATUS

The world's steepest cog railway starts its climb at Alpnachstad and tackles a maximum gradient of 48 percent, thereby passing forests, meadows and rock faces. On the north side, a gondola cableway and an aerial cableway connect Kriens to Pilatus Kulm.

With the new aerial cableway Dragon Ride, guests are practically flying up to Pilatus. It takes the cableway a mere 3.5 minutes to reach Pilatus (2073 m a.s.l.) from the intermediate station Fräkmüntegg (1416 m a.s.l.). Thanks to spacious seating, a cockpit-like structure and large windows, the cableway offers a unique view of Lucerne and its lake.

DAY 6 – INTERLAKEN

Full day excursion to Jungfrauoch including guide

Jungfrauoch

For more than 100 years, the Jungfrau railway has been making its journey to Europe's highest-altitude railway station at 3454 metres a.s.l. – right at the heart of the UNESCO heritage site "Swiss Alps Jungfrau-Aletsch". All through the year, the cog railway runs steeply up through a tunnel to the Jungfrauoch from Kleine Scheidegg. From the terminal in Grindelwald, a 3S cableway takes you directly to the station Eigergletscher (Eiger Glacier) in 15 minutes. Once at the top, there is even more time to enjoy the panorama and the adventure world.

DAY 7 – INTERLAKEN / MONTREUX

Golden Pass Train from Interlaken to Montreux (3-hour journey)
